Nursing Program admission information:

Prospective students are required to submit a completed RN application packet to be considered for the competitive selection process for admission to the program. Applications are available in the Spring of each year. Selection criteria include, but are not limited to, the GPA earned on the required prerequisite courses, TEAS score, amount of coursework completed at South Louisiana Community College, and current certification or licensure as a healthcare provider.

Applicants selected for further consideration require approval by the Louisiana State Board of Nursing (LSBN) to be officially admitted to the Nursing Program based on a criminal background check. The LSBN may approve, deny, delay, or otherwise restrict the student's enrollment. Students admitted must also meet health and physical requirements.

Graduates who receive the Associate of Science in Nursing degree will be eligible to apply to take the National Council Licensure Exam for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN), which must be passed before starting practice as a registered nurse (RN).
