Admissions Policy

South Louisiana Community College grants admission to individuals who have successfully earned a high school diploma or a General Educational Development (GED) equivalency and who the College considers eligible to benefit academically from admission. Certain academic majors may have additional admissions requirements which must be fulfilled in order for an individual to matriculate to pursue a specific degree, diploma, certificate, or technical competency area.

The College also grants admission to individuals without a high school diploma or a General Educational Development (GED) equivalency, who have passed the state's compulsory school age (at least 17 years of age as per Louisiana Revised Statute 17:221), that successfully demonstrate, via an assessment, the ability to benefit from higher education.

All eligible persons are assured equal opportunity for admission without regard to ethnicity, religion, gender, national origin, age, disability, marital status, or veteran's status.
